## **About Ocean Park, Hong Kong**



**Ocean Park Hong Kong**, commonly known as Ocean Park, is a marine mammal park, oceanarium, animal theme park and amusement park situated in Wong Chuk Hang and Nam Long Shan in the Southern District of Hong Kong. Opened in 1977 by the then Governor of Hong Kong Sir Murray MacLehose. Covering an area of 91.5 hectares (226 acres), the park is separated by a large mountain into two areas, The Summit (Headland) and The Waterfront (Lowland). These areas can be reached by a 1.5 kilometres (0.93 mi) cable car system, or the Ocean Express funicular railway. To ascend the Headland comprises several hills, visitors can use Hong Kong's second longest outdoor escalator.

The Congress was held at the Applause Pavilion at Ocean Park.

The 20th Anniversary Dinner was held at the Neptune's Restaurant at the Ocean Park.

## **About the Congress Theme**

The theme of our 2017 Congress was “**Working Together, Moving Forward & Celebrating Success**“. For organisations, teams and individuals from all walks of life, their achievements and accomplishments have almost certainly been underpinned by a culture of working together, moving forward and celebrating success.

She is trilingual (English/Mandarin/Cantonese) since she was born in Hong Kong and raised in America and Beijing. Currently a first-year college student as well as full-time athlete, she had been both a professional athlete as well as full-time student all these years. She has traveled to more than 20 countries & 50 different cities for figure skating, earning her various experience at a young age.

As a well-known athlete in Hong Kong and especially throughout social media, Maisy's skating experience has gained many audiences over the years, leading many Hong Kong citizens into knowing more about the sport of figure skating, as it is not a popular sport in Hong Kong.
